Sri K. S. Ramaiah Gupta in his letter dated 7-4-79 tendered his resignation for the post of the Treasurer of this Association on account of relinquishing his partnership with M/s. Shankar Jewellery Mart. His resignation was accepted in the Managing Committee Meeting dated 10-4-79 and the Vacancy of Treasurership was unanimously filled up by electing Sri P. R. Sampangirama Setty with effect from 10-4-1979.

Sir,

1. The Managing Committee of this Association is very eager to place before you the Audited Balance sheet, Receipts and Expenditure for the period from 1-1-78 to 31-12-78.

2. There were 283 members on the Rolls as on 24-11-78 and after those who have left for various reasons and those who have joined during the period there are, 280 as on 24-11-79.

3. Sri C. V. Hayagriv, Partner of M/s. C. Krishnaiah Chetty & Sons, Commercial Street, Bangalore-560001, Director of this Association is a nominated Member on the Regional Advisory Committee of Central Excise, Karnataka Circle and is representing the Gold Dealers. The representations made in the meetings of the said Regional Advisory Committee were stencilled and distributed among the members.

Even though we have been requesting all the members, several times, to inform their difficulties implementation of of Gold Control Law, members are not sending any subjects in the matter. Therefore, we once again request every one of you to represent your difficulties at least infuture.

Regarding the building in Chickpet, belonging to this Association and leased out to Sri Raghunandan Prasadgarg and at present occupied by M/s. Kamat Hotel (Sub Tenant) both the lessee and the Sub Lessee have filed revision petitions before the High Court of Karnataka against the

orders of eviction passed against them by the lower court. Sri C.R.V. Swamy an Advocate of Gandhinagar is looking after our interest.

Many of our esteemed members have promised to become Mahaposhaks, Poshaks and Life Members on previous occasions. Some of them have paid their amounts and the Managing Committee thank them for their generosity. Some members have not yet paid the promised amounts in spite of our several reminders. We once again request them to pay the same. We request the other members to emulate those who have become Mahaposhaks and to come in large numbers to enroll themselves as Mahaposhaks.

Sri. R. Sethurajan, Sri. S. Venkatasubba Raju and Sri. P. R. Sampangirama Setty are representing our Association in the Federation of Karnataka Chambers of Commerce & Industry, Bangalore. They have been attending the meetings conducted by the Federation of Karnataka Chambers of Commerce & Industry now and then.

Some Dealers have received notices from the Sales Tax Department to pay, purchase Tax on Jewellery bought from unregistered dealers, even though such purchases are exempted from the purview of purchase tax. This matter is entrusted to an eminent Auditor cum Tax Advocate Sri Srinivasan of Gandhinagar. Some of our members have already obtained stay orders against the unjust levy.

Sri M. N. Varada Raj, Sri R. Sethurajan, Sri K. Hemraj Jain and Sri E. V. Subbaiah are on the Executive Committee of All India Sarafa Association, New Delhi. Sri M. N. Varada Raj and Sri K. Hemraj Jain attended the Executive Committee Meeting held at Meerut on 2-9-79, specially convened to discuss the effects on Trade in enforcing section 30 of Gold Control Act 1968 i.e. stamping of ornaments. They Stressed at the Meeting and before the Gold Control Administrator at Delhi to establish Refineries and Assaying Laboratories in all important cities before enforcing this Section. They also requested the Gold Administrator to make the Gold Smith jointly responsible with the dealer for ensuring the purity of the ornaments.

They along with Sri E. V. Subbaiah again met the Gold Control Administrator when he was camping at Madras to give time to the Trade for Stamping the existing ornaments. The Gold Control Administrator was kind enough to give time till 31-3-80.

On 21-1-79, the members of our Association along with members of Several Jewellers Associations throughout Karnataka submitted a Memorandum to the Minister for Finance, Government of Karnataka requesting him to reduce the Sales Tax on Bullion and Jewellery.

This Association has submitted memoranda to The Chief Minister of Karnataka, The Inspector General of Police in Karnataka and The Commissioner of Police, Karnataka detailing the unwholesome methods adopted by the Police Department against Jewellers whenever some of

the purchases of Jewellery made by them in good faith turnout to be stolen property. They have promised to look into the genuine grievances. The Association has also submitted memoranda to the Home Minister, Govt. of Karnataka and the Police Authorities regarding the frequent thefts that are taking place in the Jewellery Bazaar and requesting them to increase the night patrol. They have promised to do so.
