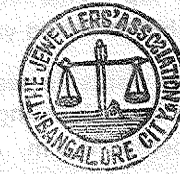

3) Sri C. V. Hayagriv, Partner of M/s. C. Krishniah Shetty & Sons (Pvt) Ltd., Commercial Street, Bangalore-560 001, the Vice President of this Association is a nominated member on the Regional Advisory Committee of Central Excise, Karnataka Circle and is representing the interests of the Gold Dealers. The representations made in the meetings of the said Regional Advisory Committee were circulated among the members for their information and guidance.

In spite of repeated requests by your Managing Committee requesting all the members to forward any problems faced by them in the implementation of the Gold Control Act, we are not receiving any representations. We presume that they have no problems.

Regarding the building in Chickpet belonging to this Association and leased out to Sri Raghunandan Prasad Garg and at present occupied by M/s Kamat Hotel (Sub tenant) both the lessee and the Sub Lessee have filed revision petitions before the High Court of Karnataka against the orders of eviction passed against them by the Lower Court. Sri C. R. V. Swamy, an Advocate of Gandhinagar is looking after our interest. The said case has not yet come up for hearing.

Sri D. A. Sreeramulu, Sri B. S. Raveendranatha Gupta and Sri C. Champalal Kothari are representing our Association in the Federation of Karnataka Chambers of Commerce & Industry, Bangalore, they have been attending the meetings conducted by the Federation of Karnataka Chambers of Commerce & Industry now and then.

Some dealers have received notices from the sales Tax Department to pay purchase tax on Jewellery bought from unregistered dealers, even though such purchases are exempted from the purview of purchase Tax. This matter is entrusted to an eminent Auditor cum Tax Advocate Sri Sreenivasan of Gandhinagar. Some of our members have already obtained stay orders against the levy. One of the writ petition No 72 and 73/79 before the High Court of Karnataka relating to this unjust purchase levy

was set aside on 16-6-1980 holding the 1970 notification valid. Your representatives have also met the Commissioner of Sales Tax in Karnataka and has appraised him of the situation and have submitted a Memorandum in this regard. He has assured the delegation to look into the matter and redress the grievences. We have also moved the matter through the Federation of Karnataka Chambers of Commerce & Industry, Bangalore.

Regarding section 30 of Gold control Act, relating to the stamping of purity on ornaments, we have met the Gold Control Administrator and have expressed the difficulties experienced by the Trader and have requested him to make the Gold smith jointly responsible for the quality since he is the manufacturer of the ornament. Consequently you are all aware of the orders received in this regard i.e. stamping both skin purity and the melting purity.

To decentralise the work load, various Sub Committees are formed to look after the affairs of the Association.

The Gold Policy review Committee appointed by the Janatha Government headed by Dr. I. G. Patel, now Governor of the Reserve Bank of India has presented its report to the then Prime Minister Hon'ble Sri Charansingh. Now Mr. K.K. Puri as the Chairman of the above said Committee has recommended 14 or 18 carat Gold Jewellery as the solution to plug the loop holes in preventing smuggling of Gold into India. This Association has sent in Memoranda to The Prime Minister and Finance Minister Government of India, The Gold Control Administrator and the Collector of Central Excise requesting them to scrap the Gold Control Act failing which not to disturb the existing law

A proforma was issued by the Central Excise Authorities to all the Dealers who have purchased gold in the Auction conducted by the Reserve Bank of India during the year 1978 to furnish details of disposals. The Association discussed the matter with all such dealers on two occasions and have come to the conclusion to give all available details.

A memorandum was also submitted to Sri K. N. Modi, President of The Federation of Indian Chambers of Commerce & Industry, New Delhi at his Camp at Bangalore, requesting him to use his good offices to see that the contemplated 14 or 18 carat rule is not implemented and that a Gold Refinery is also established in the City of Bangalore. A reply has also been received stating that the matter is being pursued with proper authorities.

A memorandum has also been submitted on 2-8-1980 to Hon'ble Sri Virendra Patil, the then Minister for Petroleum & Chemicals, Government of India, New Delhi, during his camp at Bangalore.

Sri B. N. Krishnaiah Setty, Sri K. Hemraj Jain, Sri E. V. Subbaiah, Sri P. R. Sampangirama Setty and Sri M. N. Varada Raj are representing the State of Karnataka in the All India Sarafa Association, New Delhi. They have attended the General Body Meeting of All India Sarafa Association held at Hyderabad on Sunday the 16th Nov. 1980. Sri M. N. Varada Raj addressed the meeting detailing the difficulties of the Trade. During the election to the All India Sarafa Association Sri M. N. Varada Raj has been elected as one of the Vice Presidents and Sri K. Hemraj Jain as one of the Secretaries of the All India Sarafa Association for the ensuing term.

Some of the salient points of our Presidents speech are given below for the information of our members.

Assaying and Certification Laboratories should be opened in all state capitals. The value of the metal is more and it is dangerous to carry the same long distances. Now the Government has announced that refinery will be opened in some Cities but they have not come with a scheme of opening certification laboratories. Bangalore is the capital City of Karnataka and has attained the status of an International City, Even then this City is left out of the list in providing a refinery. The State Association has submitted memoranda to the concerned departments to see that this City is included for providing

a refinery. ALSO should see that this necessity is fulfilled and that Certification Laboratories are also opened in all the Cities.

2) Quantitative limitations are imposed on the return of Primary Gold by a certified Gold Smith to a dealer. When everything is on the registers, I do not see why these restrictions are imposed. AISA should see these restrictions are removed.

3) When the central Excise authorities check the stock of a dealer, + or - 0.1 % of the entire stock in trade should be ignored, since weighing the stock as a whole and weighing the same individually, a small error is bound to crop up.

4) Some officers of the Central Excise treat old ornaments as primary gold. There are Quantitative restrictions on the possession of primary gold by a dealer. AISA should request the department to treat the stock of old ornaments as ornaments only and to increase the quantitative limits of possession of primary gold by a dealer.

5) Licencing of dealers should be made permanent as is the case with Gold-Smiths.

6) Recently a proforma was issued to all dealers, who have bought gold in the auctions conducted by the Reserve Bank of India during the year 1978, to furnish all the addresses of those who have bought Jewellery made out of RBI gold, The trade cannot identify the Jewellery



from the stock, hence it should not be insisted upon to (and that to after a lapse of nearly 2½ years)

7) Obtaining prior permission of the Central Excise authorities for a change in the Constitution of partnership firm should be done away with and it should be made only a formal one as is the case with Income Tax.

8) Regarding Sales-Tax, some States are imposing both Sale-Tax and Purchase Tax on the commodity, when the law says that only one tax is payable to a state by a dealer on one commodity. When an old ornament is purchased it can either be sold as it is or it can be made into new ornaments and sold. Either way a dealer pays Sales-tax. A dealer cannot convert the Jewel into primary gold and sell the same, which is prohibited under the Gold Control Law. Hence the authorities should be convinced that their trade attract only one tax and not two taxes on one commodity. An old Jewel is converted into a new jewel and the Commercial connotation of a Jewel remains the same and hence it should be exempted from the purview of purchase tax.

9) Harrasment of the dealers by the Police when a Thief points out a certain dealer as a person to whom he has sold a Jewel ( when actually he has not at all bought the same ) In such cases the procedure to be adopted by a dealer should be discussed threadbare and a conclusion should be reached.

10) All the important circulars issued by a State Association to its members should be sent to all the State Associations to know what is happening in the other State.

11) Reserve Bank of India is releasing gold to the Defence Gold Bond holders. There is no clarification whether a dealer who buys this gold can resell the same to another dealer. This clarification is highly essential in the interest of the Trade.

12) Since the prices of Gold and Silver have gone up several fold, it was brought to the notice of the Dealers that the Trade should pass on ornaments of good quality to the public, sticking on to the quality, rather than its price. It was also insisted that correct purity is stamped on ornaments.

13) Since the international price of silver is more than Indian price and since official export of silver and silver ornaments is banned, smuggling is on the highside depriving the Government of the official foreign exchange and other kinds of Revenue. It was urged that pressure should be brought on the government to allow export of silver and silver articles officially.

14) It was also stressed that All India Sarafa Association should see that an independent adjudicating Body is created in Central Excise Department and to hasten the adjudication proceedings.

The president of AISA suitably answered all the above points.

On several occasions some of our members complain about police harrasment whenever their purchases of old articles made in good faith turned out to be stolen one. Suitable representation and memoranda were submitted to the Home Minister, Government of Karnataka,

Inspector General of Police and the Commissioner of Police, Government of Karnataka. In this connection a circular has already been issued by our Association to all our members.

During the year under review Sri C. V. Hayagriv was nominated as a member of the Advisory panel In the implementation of section 30 of Gold Control Act by the Collector of Central Exeise.

The managing committee places on record the valuable services rendered to the Association by our Auditors M/s Suresh & Co., our Honorary Legal Advisor Sri J. Jeshtmal and our Local Auditors.
