3) Any change in the representation of a member to the Association should be intimated before 8 p.m. on 13th December 1983.

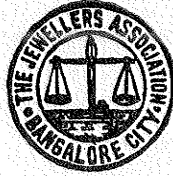
4) Guests and Children are not allowed under any circumstances.

Secretary and Joint Secretary will be Ex-officio Members of all the Sub-Committees.

The Association has had the privilege of having a get together with Smt. Sunanda Thavady, Additional General Manager, Handi-Crafts and Handloom Export Corporation of India, New Delhi at our office premises on 3-5-1983. Problems connected with Export of Jewellery and precious stones were discussed threadbare. To help the country in earning foreign exchange, Smt. Sunanda Thavady requested our members to export more and more Jewellery and stones from our state. She has promised to extend all the facilities connected therewith.

A meeting of the Ad-hoc committee of the Federation of the Jewellers of Southern Region was called at Alleppey, Kerala on Sunday the 8th May 1983. Our Association was represented by Sri M.N. Varadaraj & E. V. Subbaiah. It was decided to form a Federation of Jewellers of Southern Region with headquarters at Alleppey, Kerala. It was also decided to frame Bye-laws and other formalities connected therewith at the next meeting. This Association offered to host the next Meeting at Bangalore.

Harassment of jewellers by the police authorities was on the increase. Consequently it was decided to send a delegation to the Commissioner of Police, Bangalore. The President, the Vice-President and the

Joint Secretary met the Commissioner of Police at 5 p m. on 14th June 1983 at his office on Infantry Road, Bangalore. They appraised him of the difficulties experienced by the jewellers, whenever wrong identification of the receiver of the stolen property takes place. The Commissioner promised to look into the matter and assured the delegation that dealers having genuine transactions were protected.

Since there were some misconceptions about Circular No. 9 dated 31-3-1980 it was decided to convene a meeting of some of our members along with members of the Managing Committee at the office of the Association. The bonafides of the circular was explained to all the members present and the President assured the members that the Association will not lag behind in extending the help to our members, in genuine cases whenever our members were harassed by the police authorities. It was decided to form a sub-committee with ten members from among the members other than the members of the Managing Committee to hare and help the members whenever there is harassment either by the police or from any other quarter. The Association appreciate the work done by the sub-committee in this regard and thank each and every one of them for the same.

On 31-7-1983 the Association hosted a meeting of the Ad-hoc committee of the Federation of the Jewellers of Southern Region at Hotel Cauvery, Continental, Cunningham Road, Bangalore. Several representatives from all the Southern states namely Tamilnadu, Kerala, Andhra Pradesh, Maharashtra and Union territories of Goa and Pandicherry participated in the discussion. Our Managing Committee was in full strength. All the Bye-laws were framed and it was decided to register the same at its next meeting. The Kerala Association came forward to host the next meeting at Alleppy Ernakulam.

The Collector of Central Excise requested the Association to recommend a person to act as a member of the Regional Advisory committee for the next term. The Managing Committee decided to send Sri K. Hemraj Jain as the representative of Trade for the Regional Advisory committee. Accordingly his name has been proposed to the Collector of Central Excise. The Association thank Sri C. V. Hayagriv, the Vice-President for the services rendered by him as a member of the Regional Advisory Committee for the past two terms.

The FKCC&I, Bangalore held a meeting of all the representatives of its affiliated Associations at its office to discuss about the repressions in the enactment of the Banking law Amendment Bill. Our President and the Secretary represented our Association. It was decided to send a Memorandum detailing the difficulties of the Trade in enacting such a legislation. Our Association has sent a Memorandum on 24-9-1983 to the Hon'ble Prime Minister and the Finance Minister.

Regarding the eviction case of the Association building in Chickpet, Avenue Road, Bangalore 560 002.

The revision petition filed by Sri. Raghunandan Prasad Garg against the Jewellers Association came up before the Hon'ble Justice Jagannath Setty of Karnataka High Court on Wednesday the 9th November 1983. After some arguments the case is linked with that of Mrs. Nanjamma's case which is pending before the Hon'ble High Court.

The Income Tax Officer has concluded the assessments of our Association by including the subscriptions received from the members as liable to Income Tax and has levied a Tax of Rs. 10364 for the Assessment year 1980-81. This Association filed an appeal in this regard



and are happy to inform you that the appealing authority has decided the appeal in favour of this Association. The appeal was entrusted to M/s. H. C. Kincha & Co., Auditors and this Association thank them for the same.

The fourth Meeting of the Federation of Jewellers of Southern Region was held at 10 a.m. on SUNDAY the 27th day of November 1983 at Eranakulam. Our Association was represented by :-

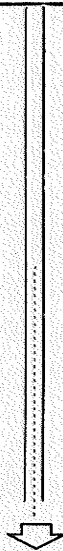

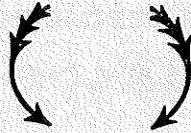
