Mr. T.P. Ramesh Babu in his letter dated 20.12.1990 to the Worshiped Mayor of Bangalore City Corporation SRI K. NARAYANA SWAMY specially made a mention about the very bad condition of Roads in and around chowdeshwari Temple Street. Added to this the chaotic condition created by intermittant blocking of the sewerage manholes have caused many an accident causing injury to lot of persons and damage to the vehicles particularly to two wheelers.

In spite of reports submitted to the corporation authorities no redressal have been made so far. He has requested the Mayor and other authoritiese to have an on the spot study of the situation.

To our utter dismay no action has been taken so far.

This association will continue to persue its efforts to see that the Corporation authorities will raise to the occassion and see that proper redressal is made.

Now coming to the local problems, we are burdened as ever before, regarding the sales tax and turnover tax. The sales tax which was at 2% earlier has been enhanced to 4%. To seek relief from this high incidence of taxation, this association in consultation with the various sister associations of Karnataka, have conducted state level meetings at the premises of the association. A number of memoranda have been submitted to the various authorities of the department of Commercial Taxes. In this connection a detailed memorandum has been submitted to our honourable Chief Minister Sri. S. Bangarappa who also holds the portfolio of Our grievance has been routed through F.K.C.C.I., Bangalore also. So far no relief is got which is most unfortunate. Low incidence of taxation, as we all are aware, encourage healthy business. Now the gold control Act is abolished. Number of Jewellery shops in Bangalore alone has increased by 3 to 4 times. To attract more revenue from the trade of gold and silver jewellery, it is highly essential on the part of the Government of Karnataka that tax should be reduced to the earlier Efforts are to be made with the concerned authorities.

Your Association hosted the executive committee meeting of the Federation of Jewellers of Southern Region at Hotel Kamath Yathri Niwas' on 18.1.1991. The General problems relating to our trade were broadly discussed, Sri. Vummidi Nandgopal, President F.J.S.R. assured that in his capacity, he will always continue to serve for the cause of our trade. F.J.S.R. ventilates our grievances with all the concerned departments at the central level.

This association recently met to finalise the proposed formation of "the jewellers' association charitable trust", There has been a very good response from the members Bangalore. and several members have come forward to donate liberally for the trust.
