Dear Members,

Seasons Greetings and Best Wishes...



I still remember, one year ago, when I was bestowed with the presidentship of a prestigious Association like ours, which has a glorious history of 70 years, steered by the envious stalwarts of our industry, famed as the most proactive Association of the country, with more than 1000 members to its credit. The presidentship was a real challenge, which I took with a lot of nervousness and uncertainty. BUT believe me my friends, this one year has been the most ECSTATIC AND OVERWHELMING period of my life.

We had never seen a more challenging and crucial era in our industry as this year. The challenges were of huge magnitudes and in multiples. The Coral issues, Central Excise related, first of its kind nationwide Bundh for 21 days, innumerable meetings and delegations, arguments and apprehensions, discussions and decisions.....and what not?. Overall a truly testing period. The probable silver lining in the challenging era was being able to do some fulfilling projects like SAI SUNSHINE, CAREER FAIR, formation of State Co-ordination Committee, bringing in Quality Control into the silver trade, various seminars and other activities. The Meeting with the Finance Minister and the chief minister(s) was a very memorable experience.

This year the Central Government has taken very stringent measures to curb the imports of Gold and inturn discourage the investments in Gold, which was quite successful, as the imports have dropped by more than a whopping 30%, since the last 2 quarters, but it has miserably failed to save the dropping rupee value. The free fall of the rupee combined with high volatility in the international markets has made our markets very risky and unpredictable. In such testing times, when the market dynamics are rapidly changing, with the trade gradually moving into bigger hands, it has become essential and inevitable to re-invent, restructure and recoup ourselves with new concepts and ideas. The only survival mantra seems to be PERFORM OR PERISH, and to perform we need to REFORM.

I once again use this opportunity to express my sincere gratitude to all the members for having given me the opportunity, not to serve, but to experience the ecstasy of being the President of such a vibrant and happening Association. My special thanks to the most supportive and a wonderful Secretary. I thank all the committee Chairmen, Board of Directors, and the Office Bearers for bearing with me, and also for sharing their wisdom and talents to take this Association to greater heights.

## **PROCEEDINGS OF THE 37<sup>TH</sup> ANNUAL GENERAL BODY MEETING HELD ON SUNDAY THE 30<sup>TH</sup> OCTOBER 2011**

At HOTEL LALIT ASHOK, Kumarakrupa Road, High Grounds, Bengaluru - 560 001

The proceedings commenced at 10.45 a.m. The Master of Ceremony Miss Akshaya requested the President of the Association P. V. Mahesh to occupy the Chair of the meeting. She then requested all the other Directors of the Association to occupy the dais.

Invocation Prayer was rendered by Sri Rajendra Prasad, by way of a Patriotic song in Kannada, after which he was given a memento in appreciation by the President.

Chetan G. R., Director, welcomed the General Body gathering.

Then Akshaya read out the list of Departed Souls of the Jewellery community, and a minute silence was observed by all, in respect of those Departed Souls.

The President of the Association Mahesh P. V. gave the presidential address. First he paid tribute to the Founding Fathers of this 70 year old Association, and mentioned that the Association has a corpus of about 2 crores of rupees today. He mentioned about the B2C Jewellery show BIJS which was conducted in April this year and that the Association earned about 10 lakhs through this show. He requested all members to diligently follow the Karnataka Gold Rate sent to all members by SMS every working day. The association, with the generous contribution of many members, donated a building block to the mentally challenged inmates of SAI VRUNDAVAN at magadi road, at a cost of rupees 33 lakhs. The Association has taken a unique initiative thru The Silver Committee under the chairmanship of Srinivas R., Director, and implemented the "99" standard for local refined silver successfully. He further gave a call to the youth in the jewellery industry to take active role in the Association to take it to greater heights. Finally he thanked all the Office Bearers and Directors for their co-operation in his tenure as the President, and all the Members & associates for their support.

The Hon. Secretary Venkatesh Babu S. was called to give the secretary's report. First, he shared that he assumed the post with apprehension and fear, but today looking back it was a combination of joy-for what could be achieved & sorrow-for what could not be. He mentioned about the various activities undertaken and also a few firsts that JAB did.

For the first time JAB could gather 3000 jewellers to protest against increase of VAT. For the first time JAB conducted a B2C jewellery show with Art of Jewellery. For the first time JAB took upon a big Social Cause project at Sai Vrundavan. For the first time JAB succeeded in formulating and implementing uniform gold rate all over the state as "Karnataka Gold Rate". For the first time JAB succeeded in standardizing local silver as "99" fine. For the first time a global bullion analyst, Mr. Paul Walker, was invited to educate us. For the first time JAB is organizing a career fair with GIA. He expressed that he was fortunate to be the Hon. Secretary at such a time.

An audio-visual report of the B2C Jewellery Show "BIJS" was presented by Chetan G. R., Convenor BIJS.

The President of the Association and the chairman of the AGM Mahesh P. V. initiated the AGM proceedings by requesting the Hon. Secretary to read the meeting notice, which was duly done.

The proceedings of the 36th AGM were confirmed by the General Body.

Mr. T. A. P. Nagaraja asked why a property was not bought for the association though the last AGM had approved it. He asked the Board to immediately finalize on the area, location of the property to be purchased and to start looking for the property at the earliest as the prices keep rising every year and there is no point in delaying the process, as the Association had about Rupees Two Crores funds. He also offered that in the event of any shortage of funds available, the Members are ready to lend in the form of interest free loans to the Association, which could be repaid later. The president assured that a sub-committee will be formed in six months and a decision will be taken. Mr. Nagaraja opposed it and suggested to buy the property in six months instead of a decision.

The Audited Balance Sheet along with statements for the year 2010-2011 were confirmed and approved by the General Body.



The General Body re-appointed M. Reddappa & Arunkumar as Auditors of the Association till the conclusion of the next AGM.

The budget for expenses as given in the AGM notice booklet was read out by the president and it was approved by the General Body.

As there were no subjects received in writing, there was no discussion.

Any other subject with the permission of the chair-

Mr. Manjunath of Ekadanta Jewellers suggested that an advisory committee be formed with senior jewelers as members to look into issues like purchase of property & taking up social cause projects. President assured that the next Board will look into it.

Mr. Ramachandra, Geeta Jewellers suggested that the Association should look into adopting a Govt school for comprehensive development. The President assured to look into this in the next Board meeting.

Mr. Ashok Kumar, Ashoka Jewellery Mart, Tumkur expressed that the MCX trading of Gold & Silver is just like gambling and the Association should make an effort to ban the trading. The Secretary informed that legal opinion has been taken and nothing can be done about it. He also opined that MCX is actually a hedging tool for jewellery trade, and it is wrong to assume that it is a platform for gambling. It is the people who are mis-using this for speculation.

Mr. Sharath Kumar, Tayi Jewellers urged the Association to make an effort to get the VAT reduced to 1% from 2%, at least by 1st April 2012. The president replied that the Association has already given a representation to the new Chief Minister Mr. Sadananda Gowda and that we are hopeful of a favorable decision by March 2012.

He also asked the Association to send gold rates to all members everyday. The Hon Secretary replied that the Association has formulated the "Karnataka Gold Rate" at 92.5% rate for 22k gold and sending it to all members, all other Jewellery Association in the state everyday by SMS. But a few members are not following the rate set by the Association, and are undercutting on this rate. He requested all members to sincerely follow this rate for the benefit and progress of the whole trade.

Mr. Mahesh, Ellore Jewellery Mart asked whether the advertisements given by certain jewelers with very low rates are correct. The Hon Secretary replied that though it is not correct, we are not able to do anything about it legally. We can only educate the customers about correct facts. He requested all members to make an effort to educate the customers.

Mr. Srinivas, Sakala Jewellers expressed that whereas the retailer's margin is being squeezed, the manufacturers are increasing their profits by not reducing stone & beads weight in the gold jewellery. The President replied that the Association cannot do anything in this matter; it's on the jeweler to solve this issue with their suppliers.

Mr. Vittal, Praveen Jewellers complained that low cartage jewellery is being unscrupulously hallmarked and sold as 22k jewellery. The President asked him to give this in writing with proof, so that the Association takes up the issue with BIS.



## 38<sup>th</sup> Annual General Body Meeting

Mr. Phoolchand of C Kisanlal Jain & Sons asked for a clarification regarding the police problem of checking bags of Jewellers on the road. Police Committee Chairman Sreedhar G. V. replied that there has been a representation to the Police department, and the harassment has stopped. He requested Members to contact the Association in case of such problems in future. The Association with consent of the Police is in the process of issuing ID cards to jewelers and their boys to avoid this problem.

Hon. Secretary proposed to increase the membership fee which is currently Rs. 7500/-, the General Body unanimously approved to increase the Associate Life membership fee to Rs. 15,000/- and the Associate Mahaposhak membership fee to Rs. 25,000/-

Mr. Manjunath of Ekadanta Jewellers asked the Board to, along with the increase in fee, specify the category of membership on offer very clearly for the benefit of prospective members. He also suggested giving a grace period of six months with the old rate. Hon. Secretary agreed that the suggestion is very good and assured that a committee will be formed and the proper procedure will be followed in a very professional way.

Mr. Srinivas of Rajat Jewellers proposed that the Association declare a holiday on all National holidays. VP Sreedhar G. V., Director Pratap Kamat & Mr. T. A. P. Nagaraja expressed their opinion that the concept of holiday is not good because there are more non-members of the Association than members, and they will be benefitted at our cost if we close for a holiday. Also in these days of Global & Mall cultures catching up, it's not a good idea to close. The General Body also agreed with this opinion and the issue was dropped.

## INAUGURATION OF SAI SUNSHINE



The Jewellers' Association Bengaluru, started off 2012 in a big way with the inauguration of "Sai Sunshine" the one of a kind and biggest social initiative undertaken yet by the Association. Mr. Babu emphatically acknowledged the fact that it was indeed a very momentous and proud moment for everyone at the Association and all the Jewelers to see the completion of such a socially contributive project. He

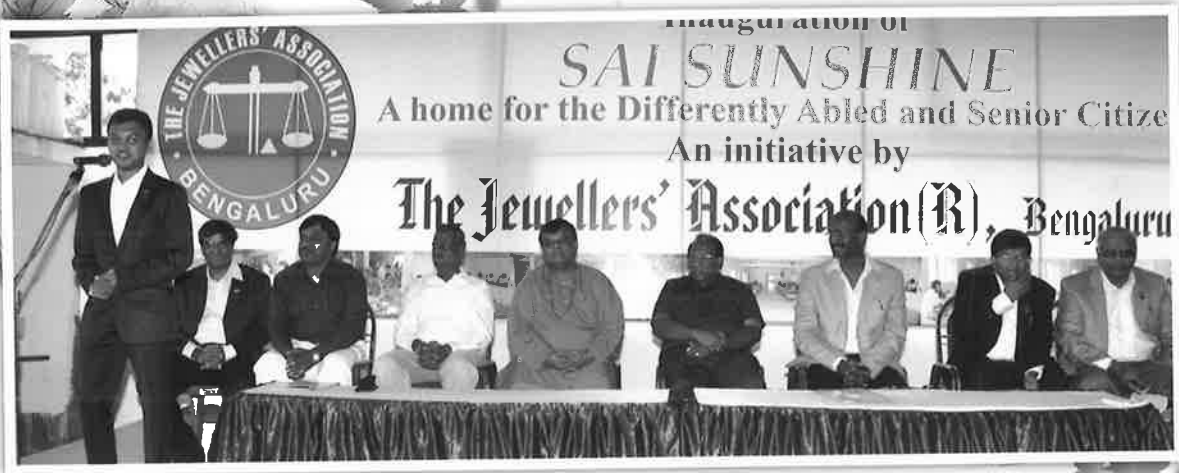

### SUMMARIZED COSTING FOR THE CREATION OF 'SAI SUNSHINE'

'SAI SUNSHINE' is an abode of care for 36 mentally challenged senior citizens. It consists of independent Ladies & Gents dormitories, with individual beds and an administrative office.

The first floor of 'Sai Sunshine' is 'Acharya Rajendra Hall', a premises designed for vocational training to over 120 differently abled students (hearing impaired) of the in-house 'Sai Vidyalaya'.

#### GROUND FLOOR: 2310 sft.

#### BRIEF SPECIFICATION INCLUDES:

The ground floor consists of 2 independent Ladies and Gents dormitories and an administrative office.

Industrial grade ceramic flooring tiles, color coated light weight roofing (with a structural facility of being relocated to the next floor level, if required), 3 track aluminum windows, painting with royale emulsion paint, one toilet, electrification as required for a vocational training facility, lighting, fans, etc.

Brief specifications include:

The RCC framed structure has been designed for ground plus two upper floors (Currently one upper floor has been built).

RCC building with solid blocks masonry, vitrified flooring, 3-track aluminum windows, flush doors, painted with royale luxury paint and apex exterior paint (for ease in maintenance), eight toilets with bathrooms having ceramic wall tiles up to 7'0" height, gypsum board false ceiling and electrification.

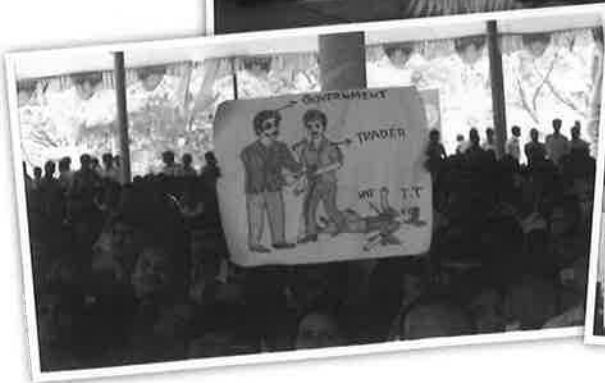

## THE KARNATAKA STATE CO-ORDINATION COMMITTEE

The second Karnataka state co-ordination committee meeting was held on the 29th April in Madekeri, Coorg District. The meeting was very enthusiastically attended by many of the north Karnataka Taluk and District Associations and it was a very big success and yet another opportunity for the unification of all Associations across the entire state. The many KSCC meetings that are being held are becoming a venue for understanding, learning and friendship among the entire Jewellery fraternity of the state.

A small seed that was sown on the 8th of December, 2011 is in the process of becoming a gigantic tree which would shelter the needs of Karnataka's Jewellery fraternity in the near future.


